Domestic Recipes.
Roasted or boiled chestnuts make a delicious stuffing for roasted poultry or game.

Cream Sauce—Half a cupful of butter, one cupful of powdered sugar, one-fourth of a cup of cream or milk, one teaspoonful of vanilla or orange extract.

Coffee Custard—Make a rich custard at least half cream; to a quart of cream and milk add four eggs, one ounce of sugar, and one teaspoonful of vanilla.

Pepper Sauce—The following excellent recipe is from the Germantown Telegraph: Three large cabbage heads; 18 green peppers; 18 red peppers; one-half pound mustard seed; one ounce celery seed; one-half pound ground nutmeg; one pound brown sugar; one tablespoonful of vinegar; five quarts good vinegar.

Christmas Pudding—Stir three-quarters of a cup of butter and the yolks of four eggs together. Add one cup of molasses and two cups of warm milk with two teaspoonfuls of soda dissolved in a tablespoonful of boiling water.

Butter Cookies—One cup sugar, one cup butter, two eggs, one and one-half teaspoonfuls cream tartar, one tablespoonful of soda. Flatten with lemon.

Ginger Cookies—If you intend a cupful of water, a cupful of good stout milk will be much lighter and more tender.

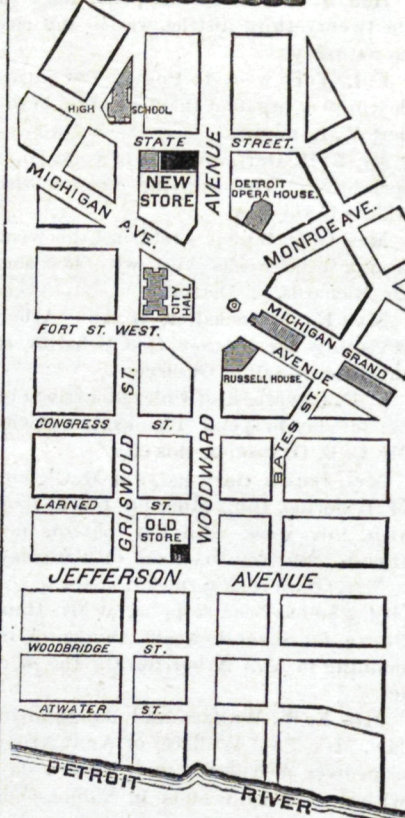
