FOREIGN CORRESPONDENCE. BERLIN, GERMANY, Oct. 8, '86. DEAR COURIER:—We called from New York in the pleasant weather of the first of July, and there never was before such a delightful calm voyage.

On the French line, although you may now and then hear a word of English, Spanish and Italian, nearly all speak French, and one has a good opportunity to refresh himself in its use before arriving in Paris.
