Water-Works Meeting, etc.  
An adjourned Water-Works meeting was held at the Court House on Friday evening last, Mayor Douglass in the chair, and J. Q. A. Searns officiating as Secretary.

The following resolutions, offered by Mr. Searns, as being before the meeting, were read by the Mayor and adopted by a motion to adopt the majority report of Citizens' Committee, for which see another column.

Resolved, That it is expedient to take the water into the Huron River above the city and not below it.

Resolved, That the water should be elevated first into a reservoir and allowed to settle before its delivery to the citizens for use.

Resolved, That it is the opinion of this meeting that the introduction of water into the city for fire and domestic purposes is expedient and necessary.

Resolved, That in view of the great diversity of opinion as to the best mode of introducing water, and the many difficulties attending its introduction as a public enterprise, it is not expedient for the city to enter upon the construction of a water-works.

Resolved, That this meeting recommend the Common Council to authorize the formation of a company or companies of water into the city for fire and domestic purposes.
