



Fire at Grand Rapids. The following account of the great fire at Grand Rapids Sunday afternoon is from the Grand Rapids Democrat of Monday morning.

Sunday, about 4 o'clock P. M. O. H. Keyes, hostler at the Bridge Street House bar, discovered a spark between the stove and the bars to be on fire, and he called the attention of the other bar-tenders to the efforts of those first on the ground to reach the spot the bars was wrapped in a fiery sheet.

The long dry, hot weather had rendered the buildings in this locality dry as a tinder-box, and before the fire department could get fairly to work the flames had jumped Kent street and were rapidly spreading in a southerly direction.

It seemed impossible to check the flow of fire that poured through alleys and streets, driving before it all who sought to stay its progress. The engines, therefore, failed to get ahead of the flames.

Along Ottawa and Lonia streets, as far north as Taylor street, people were busy packing and moving their household goods, and the fire department had been directed to get ahead of the flames.

Mayor Peterson, in chief of the Police and fire forces, with coats of oil and faces blackened, were everywhere directing, working and advising.

Telegrams were sent by the Mayor to Charlotte, Kalamazoo, Grand Haven, Muskegon and other cities, for aid.
