THE ELECTION—OFFICIAL TABLES.

We give below tabular statements of the votes polled in this county at the recent election, for Governor, Representative in Congress, Senator, Representatives in the State Legislature, and County Officers (excepting Surveyor and Coroner).

The total vote for Governor, as shown by the table (a few votes short of some of the other State candidates), is 7,902, against 7,474 votes for Governor in 1873, or 7,379 in 1870, another "off year."

The aggregate is, however, 1,376 short of the vote polled in 1868, showing either that the voting population of the county has decreased, or that there is a great deal of indifference or don't-care-ness on the part of the electors.

We shall leave our readers, and especially the defeated candidates, to analyze the tables for themselves, and determine to their own satisfaction, if possible, the why and wherefore of the great discrepancies in footings. One thing is certain: a nomination no longer carries with it the party vote.
